Exploration Green is a 200-acre urban green space in Clear Lake for recreation and outdoor enthusiasts. It provides an integrated, natural solution for catastrophic seasonal flooding holding up to 500 million gallons of storm water, while also serving as a nature preserve and recreation area. Near NASA Johnson Space Center, this urban parkland offers nearly 40 acres of wetlands and permanent ponds, supporting over 900 native species.

Flood Mitigation

Storm water detention is the primary purpose of Exploration Green. The ponds of Exploration Green mitigate local urban flooding from heavy rains by lowering the levels in area bayous. So far, the project has saved over

150 homes from flooding during Hurricane Harvey and completely mitigated flooding during Tropical Storm Imelda. Once complete, the 5 ponds will hold over 500 million gallons of storm water and protect 2000 nearby homes during catastrophic rain events!

Storm Water Wetlands

The wetlands at Exploration Green are a series of specially constructed storm water wetlands. Their purpose is to slow water runoff from storm events and detain it for a brief period of time before slowly releasing the water back into the natural waterway. Wetlands also offer a variety of benefits such as providing habitat for a variety of plants, birds and animals, and cleaning the water of potentially harmful chemicals and bacteria from surface runoff.

Native Plants & Trees

Native trees and plants are truly a special feature of Exploration Green. Our volunteers work hard to ensure a beautiful recreation space that is home to over 150,000 native plants. Native plants work to increase the area's biodiversity, providing habitat and food that attracts birds, pollinators, and other wildlife. Native plants require less maintenance and water than non-natives, while they improve air quality and prevent water runoff.
